## **STUDENT POSTER COMPETITION – CEEA-ACEG 2018**

### **Undergraduate Student Engineering Education Poster Competition**

Undergraduate students are invited to reflect on the educational aspects of their projects, experience or research by submitting a poster and participating in the Student Poster Competition at the Canadian Engineering Education Association – Association canadienne de l'éducation en génie (CEEA-ACEG) 2018 Annual Conference, and share their insights with Engineering educators and like-minded enthusiastic students from across Canada.

**Details:** A national Undergraduate Student Poster Competition organized for undergraduate students to showcase their efforts to understand or improve their engineering education experiences and/or the engineering education experiences of the students at their university. Undergraduate students who enter the poster competition get free conference registration with lunches included (does not include workshops, banquet or welcome social). The poster session happens in conjunction with the CEEA-ACEG poster session. Each submission will be assessed by a panel of judges for the quality of the presentation (both written and oral), and the connection to engineering education. One first place prize of \$100, and two runner-up prizes of \$50 each will be awarded.

### **Submission Process:**

1. **Sunday, April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018:** Submit a paragraph (about 150-word) about your work, and let us know what your poster is going to be about!
2. **Friday, April 13<sup>th</sup>, 2018:** We will get back to you to say whether your poster has been accepted to the conference.
3. **Friday, May 11<sup>th</sup>, 2018:** We will invite you to submit a one-page abstract that briefly discusses your project/experience and its findings to this date. You are encouraged to provide some background about your interests and experience in engineering (University, program, interests/clubs, etc.).
4. **Monday, June 4<sup>th</sup>, 2018:** You will display a poster (no larger than 3ft x 5ft) at the conference. Be prepared to deliver a short 5-mins presentation to the judges, and answer the follow-up questions.

### **Rules:**

2. Work submitted to this competition cannot also be co-presented as a paper at CEEA-ACEG 2018.
